

EMERGENCY SIRENS

To Be Tested

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 20

There will be a TEST of the Prompt Alert Notification System (a system of sirens) in the 10-mile area around Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station on Thursday, November 20, 2014 beginning at 3:45 p.m. The test will consist of a steady, three-minute siren tone beginning at 3:45 p.m.

There will be no reason for the public to take any action during the test.



IT IS SIMPLY A TEST



The siren system is in place to alert the public in the unlikely event of an emergency at Pilgrim Station, or to alert the public within the 10-mile area of any other emergency. In the unlikely event of a real emergency, the sounding of the sirens would mean that the public should monitor one of the following Emergency Alert System (EAS) radio stations for official information:

WBZ AM (Boston) - 1030

WPLM AM (Plymouth) - 1390

WATD FM (Marshfield) - 95.9

WPLM FM (Plymouth) - 99.1

WBZ FM (Boston) - 98.5
