Curbside Collection

Waste Solutions provides curbside collection of trash, recycling, yard waste, all with specific preparation requirements, schedules and rules and regulations. Trash, recycling and yard waste (when provided) must be at the curb by 7AM but not before 7PM the day before collection.



Trash

- One 35 gallon barrel or one bag per week
- Not to exceed 50 pounds
- Additional trash must be in a Marshfield PAYT bag that can be purchased at local stores



Bulky Items

- One item per week
- No more than 5 of one kind per year (ex. 5 mattresses)
- NO metal items or appliances
- NO sleep sofas



Appliances

- Will be picked up once a month
- Call DPW office at (781) 834-5559



Yard Waste

- Collected four times per year (see schedule on pg. 3)
- No limit on amount of yard waste
- Must be in paper leaf bag or barrel labeled **YARD WASTE**
- No Plastic bags
- Must be at curb by 7 AM
- Separate from trash & recycling

Marshfield Transfer Station and Recycling Center

- Residents & small businesses that pay a town trash fee
- Must have a sticker to enter
- Stickers are sold at Town Hall at DPW office
- Cost is \$20 (70 or older – \$10)
- Valid registration is required
- Valid January – December 31

Hours of operation:

Open Monday to Saturday
 8:30 am – 4:00 pm.
 Closed holidays.

Compost available
(for residents only).



Accepted at Transfer Station

- Recyclable items (see page 2)
- Bagged clothing
- Electronics, CRTs, TVs
- Appliances (5 per year maximum and \$10 charge for any additional)
- Scrap metal
- Tires
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Propane tanks & EMPTY gas cylinders
- Yard Waste (no plastic bags)



Used oil & oil filters

accepted only from May – October **on the second Saturday of each month** (see calendar on page 3).



Construction Debris

- Residents that have purchased a Transfer Station sticker:
- With non-commercial plates pay \$75/ton, or minimum \$35
- With commercial plates pay \$150/ton, or minimum \$100
- Pay by check only, made out to the Town of Marshfield

Curbside Recycling Guide

ACCEPTABLE

PAPER

- Catalogs
- Copy Paper & Stationery – *White & colored*
- Egg Cartons
- Junk mail – *Plain & window envelopes, labels, and staples, OK*
- Magazines
- Newspapers & Inserts
- Office Paper – *Put in paper bag or tie together. Do not put loose paper in bin.*
- Paper Bags
- Paperboard – *cereal box w/o liner, shoe boxes*
- Phone Books
- Shredded Paper – *Place in paper bag & staple bag*
- Wrapping Paper

CARDBOARD

Flatten cardboard to 3' x 3' & put in bin or tie together & put beside bin.

COMMINGLES

Glass

- Bottles & Jars – *All colors & sizes*

Metal

- Aerosol Cans – *Must be empty to be recycled*
- Aluminum Foil
- Aluminum Pie Plates
- Cans & Lids – *Aluminum, tin & steel*

Plastics – Clean

- Bottles & Containers with #1 - #5 or #7 – *i.e. Detergent, milk, shampoo, soda, sports drinks, yogurt*
- Ice Cream Tubs
- Spiral Cans – *i.e. Nuts, & potato chips, tennis ball cans*

NOT ACCEPTABLE

PAPER

- Hard Covered Books
- Napkins
- Packing Peanuts
- Paper Towels
- Pizza Boxes
- Photographs
- Soiled Paper or Newspapers
- Styrofoam ¹
- Tissues
- Waxed paper

CARDBOARD

DO NOT USE a cardboard box as a recycling bin

COMMINGLES

Glass

- Fluorescent Lights
- Glassware, dishes, ceramics
- Mirrors
- Window Panes

Metal

- Any metal item
- Grills
- Beach chairs
- Microwave oven
- Bikes

Plastics

- Any plastic bag and plastic wrap

OTHER²

- Computers
- TVs
- Propane Tanks
- Car Batteries
- Motor Oil
- Tires

¹ Secure, and place **beside** the trash.

² Bring these items to the Transfer Station. You must have a current sticker to enter.
