Curbside Collection

Residents living in a home or building of 3 units or less and small commercial establishments can be a subscriber for an annual fee of \$225. Waste Solutions provides curbside collection of trash, recycling, yard waste all with very specific preparation requirements, schedules and rules and regulations. Trash and Recycling must be at the curb by 7AM but not before 7 PM the night before collection.



Maximum Weight
50 lbs

Trash

One 35 gallon barrel or one bag per week; not to exceed 50 pounds. Additional trash must be in a Marshfield Pay-As-You Throw (PAYT) bag that can be purchased at local stores.



Bulky Items

One item per week and no more than 5 of one kind per year (e.g. max. 5 mattresses). Mattresses, box springs, sofas (without convertible spring frame), wooden furniture, wicker furniture, rolls of carpet, porcelain items, etc.



White Goods

Call the DPW office at (781) 834-5559 to schedule an appliance pick up.



Yard Waste

Collected four times per year – see schedule on pg. 3. Use an approved paper leaf bag or barrel; **NO plastic bags**. Bundle branches with twine; max length of 36”.

Marshfield Transfer Station and Recycling Center

Residents & small businesses that pay a town trash fee must have a sticker to enter the Transfer Station. Stickers are \$20 (70 or older - \$10) available from the DPW office, Town Hall. A valid registration is required.

Hours of operation:

Open Monday to Saturday
8:30 am – 4:00 pm.
Closed holidays.

Compost available

(for residents only).




Accepted at Transfer Station

- All recyclable items (see page 2)
- Styrofoam (container is beside 'bottles and cans')
- Bagged clothing
- Electronics, CRT's, televisions
- Appliances (maximum 5 per year)
- Scrap metal/bikes, grills, metal cabinets
- Batteries (vehicle, boat)
- Tires
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Propane tanks and empty gas cylinders
- Yard waste (no plastic bags).



Used oil/oil filters.


Accepted only **on the second Saturday of each month**, May to October (see calendar on page 3).



Construction Debris

Residents who have purchased a Transfer Station sticker and have non-commercial plates pay \$75 per ton (min \$35.00). Businesses with commercial plates pay \$150 per ton (\$100 min.) Make checks payable to the Town of Marshfield.

 <p>Newspapers</p>	<p>Newspapers and all flyers Stack them in your green bin or tie in manageable bundles</p>	<p>No plastic bags No elastic bands</p>
 <p>Mixed Paper</p>	<p>Items that are 100% paper, such as magazines, telephone books, junk mail, cards, bags, egg cartons, office paper, etc. Books are accepted – remove and discard hard covers Window envelopes are ok</p>	<p>No metallic or glitter gift wrap/cards No photographs No used tissues or paper towels or any other contaminated paper No wax coated boxes or cartons No paper beverage cups (coffee, pop, etc)</p>
 <p>Corrugated Cardboard</p>	<p>All corrugated cardboard, including clean pizza boxes Cut down, flatten and tie in bundles Bundles to measure no larger than 36" x 36" Place bundle(s) beside Green Bin Use string or twine to tie bundles</p>	<p>Do NOT bundle with wire. Staples are ok.</p>
 <p>Glass Bottles & Jars</p>	<p>Food & beverage glass bottles and jars Avoid breaking glass Remove lids and rinse container</p>	<p>No light bulbs of any type No mirror or window glass No drinking glasses No ceramics (plates, mugs, Pyrex®, etc.)</p>
 <p>Plastics</p>	 <p>ALL plastic bottles, jugs and tubs with the #1, #2, #3, #4, #5 or #7 symbol Empty and rinse all containers Leave lids and sprayers attached No Styrofoam for recycling; place it beside your trash.</p>	<p>No plastics with other numbers or ones with no number at all No motor oil or chemical containers No plastic bags No toys</p>
 <p>Aluminum & Tin Cans</p>	<p>ALL food & beverage cans & lids Clean aluminum foil containers Empty & rinse cans Labels are ok</p>	<p>No aerosol or paint cans with paint in container No cooking pots or pans No other metal items No paper-backed foil (take-out food lids) No foil laminates (potato chip bags)</p>



Swap Shop

Bring items you no longer want or need to the Swap Shop located at the Marshfield Transfer Station and Recycling Center (see page 1 for location and hours of operation). Items should be clean and in good condition. No stuffed furniture, sofas, chairs, mattresses or box springs.

Do you know?

Collected items are taken to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) where they are separated into different types of materials by hand or machines (or both) before being compressed into large cubes that are shipped to firms that recycle them to make new products.
