

## ENTERING THE STATION

- You must stop at the booth before you can enter transfer station
- You must have sticker on front windshield, drivers side bottom left corner



## HOW TO PURCHASE A TRANSFER STATION STICKER

- Go to Town Hall, DPW office, 2nd floor
- Bring valid registration of the vehicle you will be using
- If vehicle isn't registered in Marshfield a copy of current water/trash bill is required
- Leased vehicles need to bring license
- Valid January 1 - December 31 each year
- Sticker Fee \$20
- 70 & Older \$10
- Additional sticker in same household is \$10
- If you purchase a new vehicle and sticker is on previous vehicle, bring New registration to DPW office for a replacement sticker at no charge

### General Guidelines

- All trash must be in Marshfield PAYT bag
- Allowed one bulk item per week
- Single Stream recycling
- Televisions - \$10
- Monitor - \$10
- Refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, Dehumidifier - \$15 (purchase at DPW office or Transfer station)
- Appliances: washer • dryer • stove • microwave toaster oven, NO CHARGE
- Propane tanks / Empty gas cylinders
- **Yard waste:** grass clippings • leaves • light brush • shrubs, *trimmings 6" max diameter*
- NO PLASTIC BAGS
- Tires - remove rims, up to 20" - \$5  
Larger than 20" - \$10
- Car batteries
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Mercury containing items
- Oil based paint May 1 - October 31
- Motor oil & used oil filters - 2nd Saturday of the month May - October
- Metal must be put in container
- Bagged clothing (trailer or container)

## CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

- Weigh & Pay
- Residents that have purchased a transfer station sticker will pay \$75 ton or minimum \$35
- Commercial vehicles pay \$150 ton or minimum \$100
- Pay by check only to Town of Marshfield

## CURBSIDE SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- Weekly collections of trash and recycling
- One barrel 35 gallon or one bag not to exceed 50 lbs.
- All additional trash must be in a Marshfield PAYT bag that you can purchase at local stores, a sleeve of five is \$10.
- Waste must be placed out for collection after 6 PM on the day prior to collection day or before 7 AM on the day of collection.
- Any item that has metal on it will not be picked up at the curb Ex. (lawn chair, file cabinet, Appliances, table with metal)
- All waste must be securely contained within bags
- Waste must not contain any of the following per Massachusetts Solid Waste Regulations 310 CMR 19:017 and/or Town's Policy on trash collection.
  - Recyclable paper & glass
  - Metal, & plastic containers
  - Construction & Demolition Waste
  - Leaf & yard waste
  - TV's & computer monitors
  - White goods/metal items
  - Lead acid batteries
  - Fluorescent lights
  - Tires & Automobile parts
  - Hazardous waste




## APPLIANCE PICK-UP

- Third Thursday of each month
- To be eligible, you must have paid the trash fee.
- To be put on list, you need to call: 781-834-5559

## CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Recycling Cart - any questions about cart program call Hotline 781-834-5538 or email: dsullivan@townofmarshfield.org

- **Cart etiquette**
- Cart placement is important
- Arrows on lid must be pointing to the street
- Cart must be 3 ft. away from poles, mailboxes, trash cans and vehicles
- Contaminated carts will not be picked up.
- If you live on dead end street; cart must be on right side of road traveling out.
- All materials must fit inside your cart with lid completely closed.
- Recyclables outside of cart won't be picked up



## RECYCLING PREPARATION

Curbside program is automated single stream: Place all recyclables in recycling cart that has been distributed to your household.

- PAPER: newspapers, magazines, catalogs, paper board (cereal boxes), phone books, paper bags, junk mail, any paper.
- CONTAINERS: clean glass bottles/jars(all colors & sizes), steel/tin/aluminum cans & lids, pie plates, plastic bottles # -
- NO Styrofoam, NO Plastic bags
- NO Plastic coated paper
- NO dishes, mugs, glassware, lightbulbs, windows, mirrors
- NO Paint cans

## BULK ITEM

- Bulk item is defined as materials that pertain to size and/or weight
- One (1) item per week
- No metal items, sleep sofas, or recliners
- Rugs must be brought to transfer station

## CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP

- Special collection in January (check calendar)
- Must remove all objects (garland, lights, tinsel)
- Do Not put in a plastic bag
- Place at curb away from trash and recycling by 7 AM

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Curbside collection of yard waste will occur on designated weeks on the same day as your trash & recycling.
- (Check Calendar) 2 times in Fall and 2 times in Spring
- Leaves must be placed curbside in leaf bags or barrels clearly marked Yard Waste by 7 AM.
- Bags or barrels must weigh 50 lbs or less.



## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY

- Household Hazardous Waste Day is for Marshfield residents only.
- Proof of residency is required.
- Look at Town's web site for items accepted.
- Third Saturday in September

## KEEP MARSHFIELD CLEAN

- Annual clean-up of the Town
- Where: Furnace Brook School and Brant Rock Beach parking lot
- When: On the second Saturday in April, 9AM - 4 PM (check calendar for more info)
